- New Mexico will elect its first woman governor (since both major party nominees are women).
- Maine and South Carolina could elect their first-ever woman governors.
- Republican women top the ticket in California, winning nominations for Governor and U.S. Senate.
- Iowa, one of only four states that has never sent a woman to either the U.S. Senate or the U.S. House of Representatives, could elect its first woman senator.
